Licence Applications

All applications are initiated by the applicant and approved by the business manager before it comes to the AFSRB for processing. Business managers, <u>please check your business portals</u> to avoid processing delays.

Pre-Need Salesperson Course

To register for the CCFS pre-need course, the following requirements <u>must</u> be fulfilled before the request goes to CCFS.

- The individual must submit a student application to the AFSRB.
- The course must be paid for cost is \$400. This can be paid in the applicants portal or by calling the AFSRB.

Annual reporting for pre-need trust is now done in the business portal. A link will appear at your fiscal year end and will be available for the 120 day reporting cycle.

Failure to report within the 120 day timeframe may delay your 2026-27 renewal. All businesses are required to report.
